GET JOB READY - 3 DAY RECRUITMENT EVENT HAILED A SUCCESS FOR THE BOROUGH !!



The 'Get Job Ready' recruitment event took place on 11th, 12th, and 13th February, connecting local people with job opportunities, skills development, and employability support. Hosted across 2 venues, the event provided invaluable resources for job seekers.

Day One - Get Work Ready

The event began with 3 employability workshops, CV support, and job search assistance, helping 150 attendees enhance their interview and application skills. The session helped job seekers prepare for interviews, applications, and career development.

Day 2 - Jobs & Skills Fair

With over 70+ stalls and 35 employers offering live vacancies, the event welcomed 600+ attendees. The Application Station provided on-the-spot job application support, making it a valuable hub for networking and career opportunities.

Day Three - BWD Council Jobs

The final day focused on job opportunities within Blackburn with Darwen Council, allowing around 300 attendees to engage with 40 council staff members to explore a wide range of job openings and apprenticeships.

A huge thank you to all employers, partners, and attendees who made this event such a success! We look forward to continuing to support our community in finding meaningful employment and developing their skills.

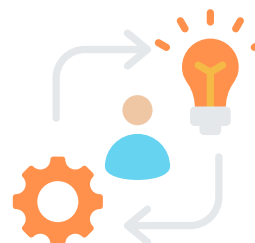

One of the highlights of May was being asked to support with the Civil Service Recruitment drive providing valuable support to those looking to work within HMRC in a customer service role. We supported 24 learners with understanding the role and responsibilities within the role, developing confidence on how to apply and complete the online interview. Out of 24 that decided to apply 18 were successful to partake in the online interview. Overall it was a hugely successful collaboration between ourselves and the DWP and no doubt 100% of the 24 will be able to use the skills developed to support them in future roles.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN BURNLEY

In Burnley we have also been providing support to those looking to obtain their SIA licence and enhance their job prospects and their own professional development.

We will be incorporating employability support and are actively engaging with local employers for those looking to move into a new career.
